Surfpack 2 builds an HTML page which resides within the user's preferred browser, supporting Internet Explorer™, Firefox and Opera. A Surfpack Startpage assembles modules for search features, news and weather, photos and horoscopes, among others, and not only reads RSS and Atom feeds, but feeds in XML, Javascript and HTML, with plug-in options.
